

Camera, Mobile phones and Recording Devices in the Nursery

KinderWorld ensure that any photographs and video recordings taken of your children in our nursery are only done with prior written permission from each child's parent or carer. This is requested when each child is registered and is updated on a regular basis to ensure that permission is still in place.

We ask for individual permission for photographs and video recordings for a range of purposes including; use in the child's learning journey, for display purposes, promotion materials including our nursery website, brochure and to use in the local press and for security in relation to CCTV. If a parent or carer is not happy about one or more of these uses the nursery will respect their wishes.

Staff are not permitted to take photographs or recordings of a child on their own devices and must only use those provided by the nursery. The nursery manager will monitor all photographs and recordings to ensure that the parent's wishes are met and children are safeguarded.

Parents are not permitted to use any recording devices or cameras (including mobile phones or smart watches) on the nursery premises without the prior consent of the manager.

During special events, e.g. Christmas or leaving parties, staff may produce photographs to distribute to parents on request. In this instance, individual permission will be asked for each child before this event. This will ensure all photographs taken are in line with parental choice. We ask that photos of events such as Christmas plays are not posted on any social media websites without permission from parents of all the children included in the picture.
